

2018 MOHSC Team Competition



Objective

The reason we have a team competition is to bring horse exhibitors from every discipline, breed and age group together to have fun, compete, and work towards a common goal while promoting themselves and their breed.

Who's Eligible?

Anyone that competes in any class during the show is eligible to be part of a team.

Cost

\$10.00 per horse/rider combination.

Team Make-up

Minimum of 5 and maximum of 10 horse/rider combinations per team. One person can show different horses but each pairing counts toward the total team horse/rider combinations.

Substitutions will be considered on an individual basis. Unapproved substitutions will forfeit any points earned. If the committee agrees to the substitution then only the points AFTER the approval will be counted.

Points

Every class throughout the show will count toward team points with the exception of Sweepstakes classes.
