Walk over E poles and double poles. Walk over poles and through box. Turn right and walk into L chute Walk out of L and over bridge. Back 4 steps.

Start beside gate.





Western Riding

Instructions

WESTERN RIDING PATTERN #1

- 1. Walk and jog over log
- 2. Transition to left and lope around end
- 3. First line change
- 4. Second line change
- 5. Third line change
- 6. Fourth line change and lope around the end of arena
- 7. First crossing change
- 8. Second crossing change
- 9. Lope over log
- 10. Third crossing change
- 11. Fourth crossing change
- 12. Lope up the center, stop and back





Trot to center of arena, stop. Start pattern facing towards judge.


- Beginning on the left lead complete 2 circles to the left, the first circle large and fast, and the second circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Complete 2 circles to the right, the first large and fast, the second small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Continue around end of arena without breaking gait or changing leads, run down center of the arena past the end marked, execute a square sliding stop.
- 4. Complete 31/2 spins to the left.
- 5. Run down center of arena past end marker, execute a square sliding stop.
- 6. Complete 31/2 spins to the right.
- Run down center of arena past center marker, execute a square sliding stop. Back at least 10 feet. Hesitate to complete pattern.
- *This pattern may be used as a lope in pattern*



Instructions

PATTERN #12

- 1. Walk
- 2. Trot
- 3. Trot logs
- 4. Side pass right 5. 1 1/2 turns right
- 6. Extended lope (right lead)
- 7. Lope right lead 8. Extended trot
- 9. Lope left lead
- 10. Walk
- 11. Trot
- 12. Stop and back





Stake Race

- 1. The start and finish line is 20 feet wide in the center of the arena and marked by two cones.
- 2. A pole is set 40 feet from the start line toward each end of the arena, so they are set 80 feet apart.
- 3. Start by crossing the start/finish line between the cones, run a figure eight around the upright poles and finish by crossing the start/finish line again and closing the eight.
- 4. At the first pole, the contestant may go left or right, just so the figure eight is run.
- 5. Rider will cross starting line, jump all three jumps, then around barrel, again jump all three jumps and cross finish line.




Figure 12: Stake Race

Be ready at cone.


Trot two square corners as shown to the judge.





Walk an arc to the judge





Execute a 270 degree pivot.


Back 5-6 steps.

Exit at an extended trot.




English Equitation Sweepstakes



- 1. Posting trot from marker I on the left diagonal down the long side
- 2. Right lead canter
- 3. Hand gallop around the end before collecting to the canter
- 4. Simple change of leads and canter 1/2 way to marker 2
- 5. Posting trot around the corner right diagonal
- 6. Sitting trot to marker 2
- 7. Halt, back one horse length.
- 8. Exit at a walk


