THINGS TO KNOW...

- Arrival is Thursday at 7:00AM or later.
- Campers may arrive Wednesday, but may not be hooked up until **noon** Thursday.
- Sweepstakes, jackpot, trail, dressage & gymkhana are not part of the blanket fee.
- When non-sweepstakes/championship classes are split, each split will be placed.
- Sweepstakes/Championship class splits will have call backs and a final.
- Class drops with refund are permitted but must be done BEFORE the class, not after. Dressage
- must be pre-entered
- Any horse/rider combo may only enter 4 dressage classes.
- Dressage tests may NOT be ridden back to back.
- Only horses that are not competing under saddle may compete in In-Hand Trail.
- **Primo Division**: Exhibitor may not have previously competed at a breed show OR won a first place in a W/T/C division at the MI Open Horse Show Championships. This is a W/T/C division.
- Helmets are required for youth in English & gymkhana classes.
- Gymkhana attire is casual: boots, pants, approp. top required. Helmet for gaming youth at ALL TIMES.
- Leadline is 8 & Under and is placed 1st 8th.
- Pee Wee is 10 & Under and is place 1st 8th.
- Ranch exhibitors are encouraged but not required to follow guidelines of Ranch grooming/tack.
- Ranch conformation is open to horses competing in classes 16, 28-32 or 35-36.
- In western riding, simple lead changes are penalized but not cause for DQ.
- No longing down of horses in main arena-controlled longing is allowed before & after show hours.
- No longing of any kind DURING show hours. (Exception, those competing in class 26)
- Awarding of high point for Ranch, Gymkhana, Lead Line & Pee Wee can be awarded early if exhibitor will not be staying until Sunday.
